Players' Championship - 26th April

The final event of the Cippenham Super League season is the Players' Championship on 26th April. This is a "Top 8" competition played under the following Regulations:

PLAYERS' CHAMPIONSHIP

- 7.1. At the end of each season the League shall promote a Players' Championship.
- 7.2. Entry shall be restricted to eight players who shall be invited in accordance with the following qualifications:
- 7.2.1. Each player shall have participated in the singles sets of at least half of his team's matches; thereafter
- 7.2.2. The five players who have the highest ratio of singles sets won to singles sets played in the highest division: ties shall be decided by the highest number of sets won and if still equal by the playing of a qualifying set;
- 7.2.3. The player who has the highest ratio of singles sets won to singles sets played in the second highest division: ties shall be decided by the highest number of sets won and if still equal by the playing of a qualifying set;
- 7.2.4. The two players who have won the highest number of singles sets in the highest division: ties shall be decided by the highest ratio of singles sets won to singles sets played and if still equal by the playing of a qualifying set;
- 7.2.5. Vacancies shall be filled in the order of singles sets won in the highest division: ties shall be decided by the highest ratio of singles sets won to singles sets played and if still equal by the playing of a qualifying set.
- 7.3. Format of play:
- 7.3.1. The players shall be drawn into two unseeded groups of four players. The final order in a group shall be determined in accordance with ITTF regulation 3.7.5 for group competitions.
- 7.3.2. The winner of each group shall play against the second placed player in the other group in the semi-finals and the winners of the semi-finals shall then play against one another in the final.


