Four titles for Ricky at Maidenhead Closed

Ricky Hardcastle won the Men's Singles title at the annual Maidenhead Closed Championships at Cippenham Table Tennis Centre in March.

However, there were some new names on the women's trophies.

The turnout was down on previous years, but in a good men's final Ricky went one better than last year and clinched the title, dropping just one game in the final to Nick Sears.

Wendy Porter and Gemma Chapman fought out one of the most exciting finals of the day, the Women's Singles, which Wendy, who plays for Cippenham in the Women's British League and Veterans' British League, won narrowly. Wendy started well by taking the first two games 11-7, 11-9, after which Gemma fought back by taking the next two games, 11-5, 11-2. Wendy snatched the final set 14-12 to take the title.

In the Women's Doubles, Wendy teamed up with Denise Rolfe and de-

feated previous champions Jan and Gemma Chapman.

The Mixed Doubles was also a close final in which Elena Tant and Ricky Hardcastle defeated Wendy Porter and David Tant 11-9, 8-11, 11-8, 16-14, while the Veteran Women's singles tile was won by Denise Rolfe, who defeated Wendy Porter in four sets.

Cippenham teams finish strongly

oth Cippenham teams finished the season in the Senior British League strongly and acquitted themselves well in mid-table positions.

The first team only just failed to hold on to the third place they occupied after the third weekend. If they had done it would have equalled their best-ever position in Division 1 South. However, York Gardens brought along a strong team and won all four of their matches during the weekend to leapfrog Cippenham and push the hosts down to fourth.

The weekend got off to a flying start for the Cippenham first team with the 7-1 mauling of Fusion II. Matt Squires was the only Cippenham loser and that was on 11-9 in the fifth and deciding game against Jamal Dennison. However, the tables were turned when Matt exactly reversed that result against Jogenes Senorin. Mark Scutts, Martin Adams and Martin Gray won their six matches with the loss of only four games.

Bottom team Crusaders were next up for Cippenham. An indifferent start saw Cippenham go 2-1 down but they came back strongly to win the next four sets and establish a winning 5-2 position before losing the final encounter to make the final result 5-3. Mark was outstanding in this match, not dropping a game, while Matt came good with a brace and Martin Adams finished the job off.

Sunday morning saw Cippenham face the rampant York Gardens side and the only joy in a 6-2 reverse was a win each for Matt and Martin Gray against the London-based club's number four.

The season finished with a thrilling 4-4 draw with divisional runners-up Bournemouth Sports. This was a match full of exciting table tennis with two sets being decided at deuce in the fifth. Firstly, Matt Squires got the better of Chloe Thomas after coming back from two games down and then Mark Scutts just failed 15-13 in the fifth against Stephen Foster. Mark fought his way back from 2-0 down but was unable to capitalise on any of the match points that would, as it turned out, have given Cippenham the extra point and a third-placed finish. This was a good team effort, however, with each of the four Cippenham players contributing to the result.

Meanwhile, the Cippenham second team were in action over the other side of the hall. The four points they gained from a win and two draws were enough to see them gain one place and finish a creditable fifth in Division 3 South.

Saturday morning was Cippenham's toughest assignment and they succumbed 6-2 to divisional runners-up London Academy II who later went on to beat the champions Property Street. Steve Smith and Richard Johnson both beat Jeremy Banks. In the afternoon Bradley King and Richard both bagged a brace while Paul Baker and Steve chipped in with one apiece as Horsham II were despatched 6-2.

On Sunday, Tony Stead replaced Steve Smith for what appeared to be two tough matches against the sides in third and fourth positions. However, Cippenham more than held their ground and emerged with two 4-4 draws.

Richard Johnson was the star for Cippenham in the morning match against Generation 2. His two wins, coupled with others from Bradley King and Tony Stead were enough to earn Cippenham a point. The host team were a little unlucky not to come away with both points as Tony and Paul both lost games in the fifth end while Cippenham's four successes were gained with the loss of only two games.
