

## Outlaws lead the way in race with Buccaneers

Cippenham Buccaneers' title challenge has faltered a little lately although they remain Cippenham Outlaws' sole potential challengers.

That happened when Burnham Nomads beat Buccaneers for a second time this season. Paul Baker won his three for Buccaneers but their only other success came from Ricky Hardcastle over Ian Baker. Dave Hyder and Elroy Hull both beat Ricky and all three Nomads defeated Muz Sabir.

Buccaneers closed the gap last week by beating Cippenham Rascals 7-3. Rafique Sarhadi maintained his 100% record for the season for Rascals while Terry Boxall, Steve Smith and Ricky Hardcastle all won two for Buccaneers

Three recent wins mean that Outlaws have leapfrogged Buccaneers at the top of the division and now lead their rivals by 14 points but the two teams have yet to play each other a second time. In their first meeting, Buccaneers won 8-2 to inflict Outlaws' only defeat of the season so far. Outlaws also have to play Burnham Nomads and so it is still too earlier to call the title race.

Outlaws won their re-arranged match with Cippenham Rascals 7-3 with Rafique once again scoring the three for the losing side. However, his tussle with Neil Bird was quite a spectacle with Rafi winning 16-18, 11-7, 11-5, 19-17! Anthony Gardner's loss to Filippo Rotunno was all Burnham Leopards got from their visit to Out-

#### Junior British League

It has been a poor season overall for Cippenham results-wise in the British leagues. However, we at last found something to cheer about when the Junior British League culminated over Valentine's weekend.

And it was the Club's highest-placed team, the girls, that contributed this welcome news. Three wins and a 2-4 loss to champions Ormesby saw them climb two places to finish a very creditable third in the Premier Division. England number seven Natalie Slater led the way with seven wins from eight at the weekend and 11 from 17 altogether. Backing her up were Haylee Potts who won half of her eight matches (8 out of 18 altogether) and Charleigh Kirby with three (6 out of 18).

It could even have been better. Natalie, to Chloe Whyte in her only defeat, and Haylee, to Jessica Dawson, lost by narrow 2-3 margins against the top team. Apart from that minor blemish against Ormesby it was 4-2 victories all the way as Burton Uxbridge, Cliffedale Chargers and Irish team Ballina were all defeated.

It was a less good story for the boys. Playing in Division 1 they lost all five matches albeit against Horsham, DHS Greenhouse Progress 2 and Barnet it was by only 2-4. Champions Burton Uxbridge 2 won 6-0 although three sets went the full distance and Team Peniel were succumbed to 1-5.

Edward Mitchell won three of his ten matches while Michael Ho and new signing Tom Baines won two each.

#### Women's British League

Charleigh Kirby put in another good performance for Cippenham in the Women's British League played at Doncaster the first weekend in February. The 14-year old, with the responsibility as number one player in a side containing older and more experienced players, shone as she won eight of her ten matches. Having put in a similar performance in the first weekend in September, her record puts her as the most successful player for Cippenham in any of the British leagues this season.

Charleigh scored when it mattered most. Against De Vere NETTS, she impressively beat both Kelly Skeggs and Cherith Graham 3-0 as Cippenham matched the Division 3 champions in a 3-3 draw. Another 3-0 win over Katherine Le Fevre and 3-1 over Stephanie Donnelly gave Cippenham another 3-3 draw with Ormesby 2 and yet another brace saw Cippenham hand out a resounding 5-1 defeat of Halton 2. Against Halton, Tanya Waller also came good with two wins and Sue Hayes chipped in with another.

Cippenham suffered defeats in the two matches in which Charleigh scored only one. Against both Byng Hall A and Woolwell, Denise Weller also scored one as Cippenham went down 4-2.

Tanya managed three wins from eight altogether during the weekend while Denise and Sue contributed two each from six starts as the team eventually finished in fifth place.
