

Winners and Runners-up of ALL THREE Events at St. Ives

COMPLETE DOMINATION



Cippenham teams swept all before them at the annual St. Ives Junior Team Tournament during the weekend of 18/19th November, being champions and runners-up in all three age groups.

This is the second year running that Cippenham has won all three events and the Club equalled last year's achievement of the champion teams winning every match 3-0. This time, however, Cippenham completely dominated proceedings in providing the beaten finalists in all competitions and only lost one set all weekend to teams from the rest of the country.

On Saturday the Under-17 event provided a reversal of roles with Cippenham "B" beating Cippenham "A" 3-0 in the final. The "B" team consisted of Thomas Mitchell, Gemma Chapman and Ross Drabble while the "A" team players were Warren Brooks, John Camilleri and David Hayes.

On the same day the Under-12 event was won by Cippenham "A" in the guise of Bradley Evans, James Milton and Sylvana Bielec over a Cippenham "B" team made up of Gavin Evans, Myles Evans and Joe Misseldine.

The triple was attained on Sunday in the Under-14 event when Slough's national Leach Cup champion side of Bradley Evans, Tom Mitchell and David Hayes, playing as Cippenham "A", beat Cippenham "B" 3-0 in the final. The "B" team players were James Milton, Emily Tucker, Gavin Evans and Myles Evans.

SUCCESS IN REGIONAL TRIALS

Cippenham players dominated the Southern Region Final Trials played at their home club on 26th November, providing all the winners and most of the qualifiers for the National Trials. The home players finished in all the top four places in the junior boys' (U17) event: 1. Bradley Evans (aged 11!); 2. John Camilleri; 3. Warren Brooks; 4. Robert Hansell. Bradley was in commanding form throughout the day winning all of his six matches with only Robert providing any resistance. John lost only to Bradley while Warren lost to both Bradley and John. Cippenham's fifth player of the seven qualifiers, Thomas Mitchell, disappointed with only one win and finished sixth.

It was 1-2-3 for Cippenham in the junior girls with Emma Human on top followed by Emily Tucker and Francesca Parnell. The up-and-down form of Emma prevailed in the ascendancy throughout the competition and she was taken to a deciding game only once. Cippenham's other player, Katherine Tweedy, played well to take three of her opponents to a decider but could not quite clinch a victory. Cippenham's number one, Gemma Chapman, was exempt from this stage of the qualification for what will ultimately be places in the National Masters.

With Bradley Evans exempt, David Hayes finished first in the cadet boys (U14) with James Milton third. Myles Evans (aged 9) finished eighth, winning only one match but had the satisfaction of taking the winner to 21-19 in the third. In the cadet girls the two qualifiers for the National Trials were Emily Tucker and Sylvana Bielec with Caroline Linz finishing third and Eleanor Tweedy sixth.

Latest England Rankings

Cippenham has 4 of the top 11 listed in the latest England U12 boys rankings - and three are from one family. Gavin Evans (aged 7) is the youngest player on the list, one place ahead of his brother Myles (9). Owing to a change of policy Kai Milvek, who is Estonian and lives in Tallinn, makes her debut on the England(!) ranking list.

Girls Lead The Way in National League

Cippenham Girls C finished the first stage of the National Junior League Southern Region in indomitable form, losing only 2 sets out of 48 in the eight matches, all of which were won. The team of Helen Smith, Katherine Tweedy and Sylvana Bielec take a twelve point advantage into the second stage which commences this month. Both Helen and Sylvana boast a 100% record so far and their victories in the second session included a 5-1 success over Bournemouth and 6-0 over IMPACT (Reading), the closest challengers.

The Girls D and E teams finished 4th and 5th respectively while the Boys C and D teams were 3rd and 7th in their section. The top boys' team are nine points off pace-setters Bournemouth A and two away from Chiltern-CHS A. Star of the team on the second date was Gavin Evans who won all of his eight matches. Incredibly, in this U17 competition, Gavin is just seven years old! He is set to follow in older brother Bradley's footsteps. Bradley is already twice an England national champion at U10 and U11 level.

Tougher This Time In British League

The Cippenham team in British League Division 1 South had an unsuccessful weekend of 25/26th November. Taking an unbeaten record to Barnet they were unable to further their points tally as they lost three matches to the best three teams in the division. 3-5 reverses were recorded against DML Plymouth and Barnet II while BATTS Team Peniel won their encounter 6-2. Clive Payne was the most successful with 4 wins from 6 matches.

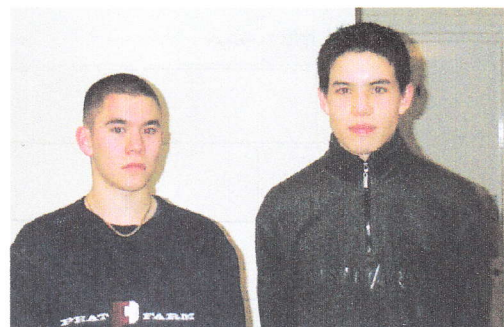
