Men cruise to VBL divisional title

The Cippenham veteran men's first team became Veterans' British League Division 2B champions and they did it in a cantor, winning all ten of their matches over the season. Their impressive sets aggregate was 54-6 and three of the sets lost were by reserves playing up from the second team on the final day. This has earned the team promotion to Division 1 for next season.

Andy Trott, Martin Adams and Hari Gehlot were in imperious form throughout. Saturday's matches saw them beat Seasiders (Blackpool) and Dewsbury both 6-0 and then cap off a fine day with a 5-1 win over local rivals Ashford. Hari's loss to Steve Davis in the final encounter of the day was the only blip in an otherwise flawless performance.

With Andy Trott not available on Sunday, Cippenham promoted Tony Stead and Samson Bekele from the second team for one match each. Tony added to his reputation with a win over John Poysden as Cippenham beat South Essex 5-1 in the morning but Samson was not able to match this against Foresters D but this did not stop Cippenham from keeping up their one hundred percent record with a 4-2 victory. Andy finished the season unbeaten with Martin losing only once and Hari twice.

Cippenham's second team, consisting of Mike Rhodes and Paul Baker, in addition to Tony Stead and Samson Bekele, rounded off the first round of matches with a 3-3 draw against Crusaders and a 5-1 win over Ashford. Those points maintained Cippenham's fifth place in Division 4A but meant that they would play the final three matches in a group comprising the bottom four teams in the division.

Those three matches were all won easily to finish a very good weekend for the two Cippenham men's teams. The late Saturday match saw another 5-1 win over Ashford and this was followed on Sunday win a 6-0 drubbing of Draycott and 4-2 against bottom team Archway Peterborough 2. Over the season, all four Cippenham players won at least half of their matches with Samson on 64%, Paul 62%, Mike 56% and Tony exactly 50%.



However, the results were not so good for the Cippenham women's team playing a little out of their depth in Division 1. Saturday morning saw the team of Denise Weller, Mary Heffernan and Sue Hayes beaten 6-0 by Ashford but they bounced back well to gain their only point of the first stage with a 3-3 draw with Milton Keynes. All three Cippenham players contributed a win apiece in a much-improved team performance.

The division was then split with Cippenham placed, as the bottom team, in the lower half for the final three matches. A 5-1 defeat at the hands of Irish Colleens, during which Sue scored Cippenham's only point, was followed on Sunday morning by a 6-0 defeat at the hands of London-based Fusion B. However, the season ended with another 3-3 draw with Milton Keynes, replicating the result against the same opponents from a day earlier. This time

Runners-up in both events were Maciej's teammates: Hari Prasad in the Men's Singles and Ricky Hardcastle in the Tweenies'. However, the tables were turned when Ricky got the better of Maciej in the Division One Singles.

Trojans secure Maidenhead title

Congratulations to the Cippenham Trojans team of Ricky Hardcastle, Macuej Dlugozima, aided by Hari Prasad, Anthony Gardener and Michal Garski who have secured the Maidenhead League title with two matches to spare.

The title-winning moment came in late February against defending champions Cippenham Saxons in a 9-1 victory for the new champions. Only a first doubles defeat of the season for Trojans prevented the whitewash!

Saxons, still, look set to gains the runners-up trophies and only a unlikely series of results from NWCA Bluejays, who Saxons meet this week, can deny this.

Cippenham Titans have fallen off top perch in Division 2 but are only three points behind leaders NWCA Raiders and have a match in hand. Don't count out Cippenham Vikings who, despite currently being in fourth place, are only two points off top spot with two matches in hand. It's going to be close! The possibility of a one-two for Cippenham teams in both the top two divisions is still alive and results in March will determine the outcome.

Spartans look set to win Division 3 despite having as many as five matches still to play. They lead their nearest rivals by eleven points and have a game in hand.

National Cadet Cup is coming to Cippenham

Another prestigious event is set to come to Cippenham. On 28/29th March, Cippenham will host the National Cadet Cup featuring the top ten cadet (under-15) boys and girls in the country.

The National Cup replaced the National Masters a few years ago. Cippenham previously hosted the National Masters many times, starting with the very first season at new newly opened Centre in 1996-7. This was a landmark event for Cippenham as two of our players, Gareth Herbert and Jesper Hougaard won the two boys' events—juniors and cadets. Eleven time in a row Cippenham hosted both the Junior and Cadet Masters and then it was one or the other until 2010.
