TOURNAMENT REGULATIONS

1. Every entrant must be affiliated as a Compete Member or be a member of another National Association in membership of the ITTF.
2. TTE Regulations Part A (Regulated Competitions) and Part B (Tournament Regulations) apply to the tournament.
3. ITTF Regulations for International Competitions apply to the tournament except where otherwise specified in TTE Regulations Parts A or B, or in this form.
4. All players may be required to umpire at least one match in each event entered.
5. All matches shall be the best of five games up to 11. The final order in a Group shall be decided as per ITTF Regulation 3.7.5.
6. This is a female only event. Competitors must have been born in 2002 or earlier for the Over 21 event and in 2003 or later for the Under 21 event.
7. Competitors must report to Control on arrival and must not leave the hall without obtaining permission. Players absent when called upon to play are liable to be scratched.
8. The Organiser reserves the right to merge/cancel events if entries are low.
9. Players' Clothing: main colour of clothing must be different from colour of ball.
10. At the discretion of the Referee competitors may be permitted to practise on match tables not in use. Dedicated practice tables will not be available.
11. No competitor or official shall engage in betting on players or matches.
12. Decisions on points of fact by an Umpire appointed by the Referee shall be final. The Referee's decision shall be final on points of law, in any dispute as to the interpretation of these Regulations and in any matter not covered by them.
13. Entrants who do not attend the tournament without a reason acceptable to the Referee may be reported to Table Tennis England.
14. Doping shall not take place either before or during play. Doping control tests may take place.
15. Completion and submission of this Entry Form signifies agreement by the entrant to the conditions of the competition, including any variations of ITTF regulations.
16. Competitors will not be allowed to glue up within the confines of the Centre under any circumstances.
17. Notification will be sent after the draw has been made, notifying competitors of the first match time, provided they have provided either an **email address** or a **stamped addressed envelope**.
18. The organising committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
19. Trophies will be awarded to the winners and runners up.
20. Photo/livestreaming: Cippenham Table Tennis Club may be taking photos and live streaming matches during this event which may include (but not limited to), using them in our printed and online platforms, social media, press releases and funding applications. Playing Format

In each event, players will be drawn into groups of 3 or 4 players with the top two players progressing to the Main Event and the remaining players into the Consolation Event.

If it becomes necessary to restrict entries, priority will be given in order of receipt.

The draw will take place on Sunday 21st January 2024.

No refunds of entry fees will be given after the draw has taken place.

VENUE

There is no charge for admission to the venue.

Changing rooms, including hot showers, are available at Cippenham Table Tennis Centre.

Free car Parking is available at the Centre at owners' risk.

Food and drink, but not full meals, will be available.

Smoking is not allowed in any area of the venue.

All entries and event details are subject to COVID-related restrictions, or protocols that Table Tennis England may deem necessary. Venues used for events may impose COVID restrictions that go beyond government guidance.

PLAYING CONDITIONS

Play will be on 8 Butterfly tables with Butterfly National League nets and posts and Butterfly 3 Star white plastic balls, Minimum court size will be 10m by 5m enclosed by surrounds. Minimum height of playing area and lighting is 4.0m. General high-frequency fluorescent lighting with intensity 600 lux over the playing surface: Tarkett Compact 2.0 plastic floor over sprung wood base. Score indicators will be used for all matches.
