

8 points from a possible 24-another slow start to the season

Slow Saturday but BL teams pick up on Sunday

Cippenham made their traditional slow start to the British League season, although the second day saw all teams picking up points especially the third squad who experienced a Super Sunday.

Once again, Martin Adams was the most successful player with five wins out of eight but he received insufficient support from the rest of the team. Just one point out of eight was the dismal return for the Cippenham first team playing in Division One South at their home venue. Cippenham were a little unlucky in that two matches were lost by the narrow margin of 5-3.

Our only point came in the 4-4 draw with York Gardens on Sunday morning. This was a match that promised to provide both points as Cippenham won five games more than their opponents but three sets were lost 11-7 in the deciding fifth game or closer. The two 5-3 losses came at the hands of Brighton and VRS Generation (Fareham) but, once again, a 11-9 fifth game defeat for Mark Butler in the match against Brighton and 11-8 in the fifth for Rob Lemon in the Generation match determined the difference between defeat and elusive league points. Sandwiched in between was a horror 8-0 defeat to Urban Progress, a team relegated from the Premier Division last season.

Lee Dredge, with three wins, played well but Mark Butler and Rob Lemon tasted victory only once each.

The Cippenham second team, playing at the same venue and at the same level as the first team in Division One South and Midlands fared somewhat better, gaining three points, tying the aggregate for the whole of last season! As with the first team, it was the Sunday morning match that bore most fruit. A 5-3 win over Fusion II was gained with braces from Danny Baxter and new signing Martin Gray with Cippenham's other new signing, Owen Clutterbuck, adding the fifth.

Steve Munson was the star in the other profitable match from which a 4-

4 draw was gained from Urban Progress II. Steve beat Csaba Baliant and Darius Atashroo, both three-straight, while Owen and Danny, respectively, also demeaned the same opponents.

Martin Gray also won one each in the 6-2 defeats to Sycamore and OLOP IMPACT to finish with four wins from eight matches on his Cippenham debut while Danny did better with four out of six. Owen won half of his six matches, Steve had a similar return from four matches, while Mark Jackson and Steve Buck failed to score in their six and two matches respectively.

Chris beat Nicolas Ravalec in five and Eddie got the better of Anthony Johnson in four. With a bit of luck the result could have been a draw or even a win for Cippenham with Eddie losing out in five to Adam Brewer and Chris losing in four close games also to Brewer. Steve Smith had two close contests losing deuce in the fifth to Johnson and a close fourgame match with Ashford number four Trung Tran. Phil Prady, playing at what proved to be a lofty number three, also lost both of his matches close in four.

In the afternoon the same line-up succumbed to Hastings, catching them on a day when they fielded one of their strongest sides. Chris defeated Rose Rainton, ranked 15 in the country, three-straight but lost to Paul Barry. Eddie also lost to Barry but defeated Hastings number three Matt Porter. Porter edged a tight game with Steve to come through 7 in the deciding end having led 2-0, Steve then beat Roger Pingram in similar fashion, 2-0 up but leaving it until late in the deciding end to come through 11-9. Again Phil lost both of his matches in four games. Final score 3-5.

Fielding a different team on Sunday, things took a turn for the better. First match was against Fusion III who had looked impressive winning both of their matches on the Saturday and looked set to continue this form racing

to a 2-0 lead, Chris Hansell and Paul Baker losing to David Fraser and JoJo Senorin respectively. From then on it was plain sailing as Cippenham only dropped a further four games on their way to a 6-2 win. Eddie Mitchell winning both of his matches and Tony Stead also securing a maximum on debut.

The final match of the weekend against DHS Greenhouse Progress IV also started badly with Progress winning the first two sets, Paul losing out to Joseph Mensah and Chris losing in five to the reigning National Under-12 Champion Igor Morais. Cippenham won the next four sets before Eddie also lost to Morais in three straight games. Tony then clinched the win with a 3-1 win over an inspired Bhavin Savjani who pushed Tony all the way. Again, a maximum for Tony with the others chipping in with one apiece.

In what is shaping up to be a very competitive division, after the first weekend the third team finished with four with two wins and two losses, Only two points separate all eight teams with the leaders on five points and the bottom team on three!

Highlights of the weekend were Tony's maximums in his first appearance in the Yellow and Blue, Eddie's fine win over David Fraser which saw Eddie's consistent attack finally break down the magnificent defensive play of Fraser, and Chris' straight-games win over one of the country's best female players.
