Cippenham teams head all three divisions of the Junior British League after the first half matches played in Wolverhampton over the weekend of 14/15th October.

The girls' first team, sponsored by Addleshaw Booth, are in a commanding position to retain the Premier Division title they won for the first time last year. Wins in all five matches have resulted in a three point advantage over second placed BATTs. Karen Shepherd remains on 100% while Joanna Parker has lost only once and Gemma Chapman twice.

On Saturday, Addleshaw Booth Cippenham started up with a 6-0 victory over Glamorgan and then inflicted the same result over Gautby. Another convincing result was the 5-1 win over Team Peniel A (Brentwood) late Saturday afternoon. Sunday again started off in fine style as BATTs (Harlow) were despatched 6-0 before the half-way lead in the division was clinched with a 4-2 win over London Progress.

Hardly less successful was the Girls "B" team which heads Division 2, also with a 100% win record. Francesca Parnell and Gemma Hollett have 9 wins out of 10, only one ahead of Emily Tucker. Cippenham began with a 5-1 win over Uxbridge Briar (Burton) and then won two successive matches by 6-0. First to fall were Darlington and then De Vere Sudbury also on Saturday. These were followed on Sunday by wins over Chelmsford 5-1 and Oakbank 4-2.

Buckinghamshire juniors, represented entirely by players from Cippenham played superbly to win two and draw one of their three matches in the Premier Division of the County Championships held at Cippenham over the weekend 21/22 October. These results place Bucks second in the table behind Surrey who Bucks will play in the second half fixtures at Grantham in March.

This was Bucks' first season for many years in the Premier Division, having been promoted

from Division One last year, and the first set of results augur well for the young team for several seasons to come. The team comprised Robert Hansell, Bradley Evans, Warren Brooks, Gemma Chapman and Emily Tucker.

Bucks got off to a flying start on Saturday with an 8-2 victory over Kent. Robert, Bradley, Warren and Gemma all won both of their matches with only Emily's eluding the home team. Sunday brought even better performances as Bucks first drew with defending champions, Glamorgan, 5-5, and then beat Middlesex 7-3. Throughout the weekend Warren remained unbeaten in his six matches while Bradley and Robert were defeated only once each. For Robert this was a special achievement playing at number one in the team and for Bradley, the current England Under-11 champion, it was against players up to five years his senior.

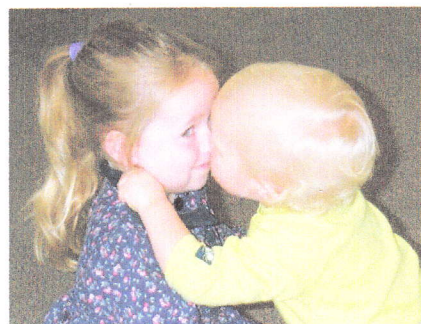
