Awards for Steve, Lucie and Rachael

Cippenham Table Tennis Club celebrated the twenty-third anniversary of the opening of its purpose-built table tennis centre with a party and awards presentation in November. The evening was presided over by Club Chairman Ken Phillips and Club Secretary Graham Trimming who began by presenting chocolate gifts to the Club's many volunteers.

Ken then addressed the gathering, extolling the virtues of the strong volunteer force at the Club at present and praising the recent upgrading of the lounge area. On the playing front, the junior section is also very buoyant at the moment. Ken travels the country with the junior players and often hears very kind remarks about Cippenham Table Tennis Club and its premises as being one of the very best in the country.

The first of the main presentations was for the Junior Player of the Year, an award that perpetuates the names of Alan Farral and Terry Boxall, former coaches at the Club who have since sadly passed on. This year the award went to the Club's highly promising young player Rachael Iles. 12-years old Rachael has made such good progress in the past year that she surpassed expectations by finishing as runner-up in the National Under-12 Cup last season against all the very best that England has to offer in that age group. Rachael is one of a group of girls at Cippenham with very bright futures in the game.

The second presentation was for the Senior Player of the Year. This year the winner was Lucie Bouron who, unfortunately, was not able to be present to collect her award. 24 years-old Lucie is an established member of the Great Britain para team where she displays her immense skills from the confines of a wheelchair. She also assists with the elite coaching sessions, using her speed to help with the most promising younger girls.

The main event on such an evening is the presentation of the Karen Mitchell Outstanding Contribution Award. This

award marks outstanding contributions from rank and file members of the Club outside of the list of Officers. It is dedicated to those individuals who have given outstanding service to the Club and whose contributions might otherwise remain unrecognised.

This year the award was presented to Steve Piercey. Steve is one of a num-

ber of parents who are becoming increasingly helpful in a number of ways around the Club. He is often seen at weekend events, assisting the organisers in various capacities and is a mainstay of the group of people who meet on a Friday evening to set up for those weekend events.

The Junior British League got underway at Derby at the beginning of November with the Cippenham girls' team being placed in Division 3. Cippenham's two young local stars, Rachael Iles and Anna Piercey, ranked 22 and 23 respectively in England cadet girls, needed a third player to make up their team. Cippenham Head Coach Ken Phillips made an inspired selection in Hannah Silcock from Jersey and she led the team brilliantly, winning nine of her ten individual matches. Anna won seven and Rachael won six as Cippenham won four of their five team matches and sit comfortably in second position in the division. All three members of the Cippenham team are just twelve years of age and playing in a competition that is for under-18s.

The weekend started with a match against Halton 2. The three Cippenham girls won the first four sets with the loss of just a solitary game to secure the maximum yield of league points before Anna lost to Milly Hanrahan. Rachael then won her second match against India Odley to give her team a 5-1 final result.

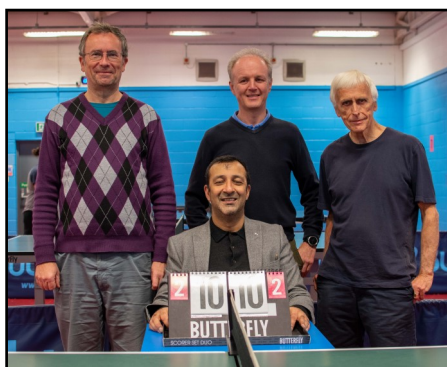

The one set-back during the weekend came next as Cippenham lost to divisional leaders St Neots. Unfortunately, Cippenham were on the losing end of the first two as Rachael led 2-0 against Chloe Pryke but could not hold on to her lead and then Hannah suffered her only reverse of the weekend against Stefania Popa. Anna got Cippenham back into the match with a close win over Aditi Dhillon and Hannah drew her team level beating Pryke 3-0. However, Rachael and Anna were unable to win their final two singles and the match was lost 2-4.

Cippenham got back to winning ways late Saturday afternoon with a 4-2 win over Britannia. The Ipswich based team actually went 2-1 up but Cippenham roared back to win with Hannah winning twice and Rachael and Anna once each.

In contrast to Saturday, Sunday's matches were plain sailing. Ackworth were beaten 5-1 in the morning and then Cippenham went one better against Lillington in the afternoon, the final result being 6-0. Over the two matches, four of the sets were close enough to require a deciding game but overall it was a dominating display from Cippenham with Hannah and Anna winning all their four games and Rachael winning three times.
