Starting with the British League weekend of 4/5th September, the Cippenham Table Tennis Centre will once again be fully functional. Even though the builders are still on site, the Centre now has access to newly built changing facilities and state-of-the-art wash rooms, complete with sensitive lighting that sparks into action as a person approaches. That is all



part of The Westgate School's upgrade of its facility to enable use by disabled pupils. The School also has new treatment and physiotherapy rooms included within.

The Club took advantage of the fact that builders were on site to extend our





lounge and kitchen areas. That build programme finished in July. Enter Club stalwarts Alan Farral and Terry Boxall. They have worked very hard over hundreds of hours fitting out the kitchen area, including all electrics (Terry's speciality), plumbing, cabinet fitting and finishing. Of course, Alan and Terry were not the only ones involved in the project. Slough League Membership Down Again

For several years now the Slough League, in common with most others in the country, has been losing members. For the coming season membership is down to sixteen teams and these have been grouped together to form First and Second divisions each of six teams and a Third Division of only four teams. The reason for this split, rather than two divisions of eight, was the fact the a second division of eight teams would have contained a great disparity in playing standards.

The format of the season will be in two parts. The First and Second division teams will play each other three times over a fifteen week period, interspersed with Dilger Cup rounds. The Third Division teams will play each other four times each making twelve matches in the same fifteen week period. After that the First Division will play another series of five matches but two-a-side while the Second and Third Divisions come together, like last season, to play a handicap competition in two groups of five followed by a final that will be played alongside the Slough Masters Tournament.
